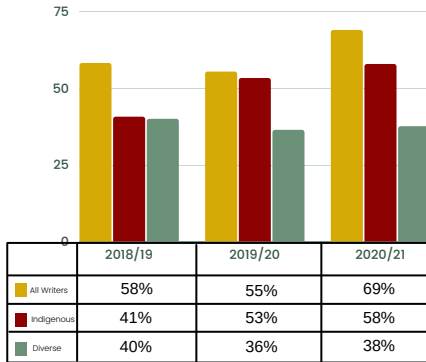

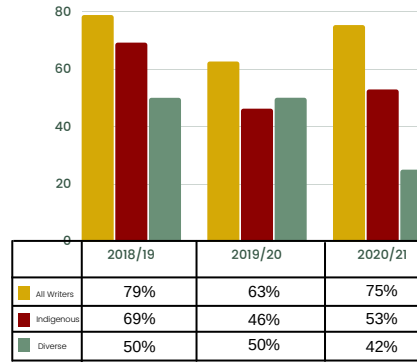
LITERACY AND NUMERACY EXPECTATIONS GRADE 4 AND 7

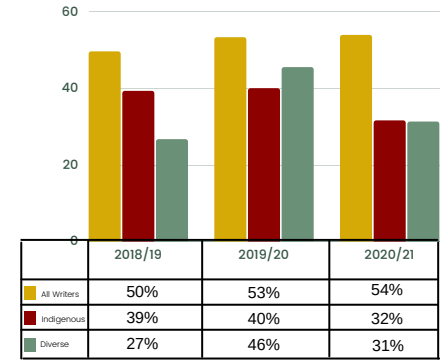
Grade 4 Reading



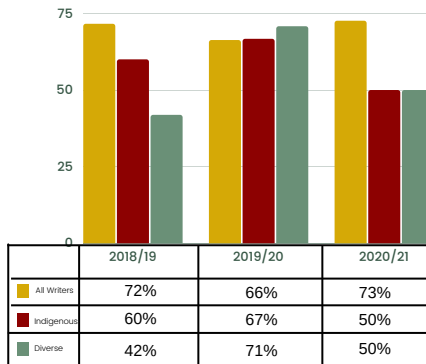
Grade 4 Writing



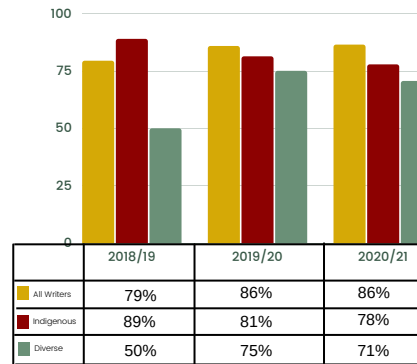
Grade 4 Numeracy



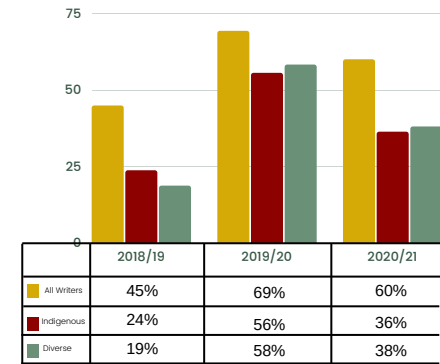
Grade 7 Reading
